

## HCCA DRESS CODE

The dress code and grooming of our students conveys an image of our school, influencing how others respond to and judge Holy Cross. Dress also contributes to the overall school climate in which the students learn. Thus, all students must wear the approved uniform.

### PRE-SCHOOL AND KINDERGARTEN ATTIRE:

Boys and girls are required to wear either red or white t-shirts, polo shirts, or sweatshirts with the school monogram in navy blue and white. When going on a field trip, a red shirt must be worn. Pre-school and kindergarten students may wear the pants or shorts of their choice. Students should wear athletic shoes to school (no sandals, flip flops, or boots).

### ELEMENTARY AND MIDDLE SCHOOL ATTIRE—GIRLS:

The official **dress uniform** consists of the Holy Cross plaid jumper with a long or short sleeved “Peter Pan” collared shirt (with or without navy piping) or a white “Middy” blouse. Girls must wear either navy or black privacy pants or navy blue or white tights with their jumpers. Dress shoes, not athletic shoes, are to be worn with the dress uniform. If not wearing footed tights, girls should wear navy or white dress socks. **NO HOODIES, SWEATSHIRTS OR LEGGINGS ARE ALLOWED ON FORMAL DRESS DAY. Girls must wear their dress uniforms on Formal Dress Days (Wednesdays) and on Field Trips as designated by the teacher.**

*The following are options for any day of the week except Formal Days and Field Trips when dress uniforms are required:*

<u>Red Sweater Vest</u>	with	No logo required May be worn over a white uniform shirt or over a white oxford shirt with any combination of pants or shorts above It may <b><i>not</i></b> be worn with the formal dress uniform.
<u>Red Sweatshirt</u> <u>(navy and white monogram)</u>	with	With navy shorts, pants or plaids
<u>Navy Blue Sweatshirt, Cardigan</u> <u>or Jacket (monogram)</u>	with	With navy shorts, pants or plaids
<u>HCCA Hoodie</u>	with	With navy shorts, pants or plaids May <b><i>not</i></b> be worn with formal dress uniform
<u>Dress Shoes</u>		Required only when dress uniform is worn. Low cut, heeled black or navy leather shoes or white/navy or white/black saddle shoes. No high heels. Plain navy or white socks or tights are required with dress shoes.

Athletic Shoes will be worn with navy pants, shorts or skorts. Please wear appropriate socks with athletic shoes. Please do not wear multi-colored, patterned socks with the school uniform. Socks must match each other.

Plain black belts are required with any shorts or pants that have belt loops.

*\*Dress, shorts, skirt and skort lengths must not be any more than three inches above the knee at any time throughout the school year.*

## ELEMENTARY AND MIDDLE SCHOOL ATTIRE—BOYS:

The official **dress uniform** consists of navy pants, light blue or white button-down oxford long or short sleeved shirt (no logos or emblems of any kind), navy or black socks, and a black belt. Black dress shoes and black socks are required when wearing the dress uniform. **NO HOODIES or SWEATSHIRTS ARE TO BE WORN ON FORMAL DRESS DAYS. Boys must wear their dress uniforms on Formal Days (Wednesdays) and Field Trips as designated by the teacher.**

*The following are options for every day of the week except Formal Dress Days:*

Athletic Shoes are required for P.E. Please wear appropriate socks with athletic shoes.

Socks much match each other.

Black belts are required with any shorts or pants that have belt loops.

Students' hair must not cover their eyes.

### MIDDLE SCHOOL ATTIRE—6TH THRU 8TH GRADE:

Middle School Girls may follow the dress code of the elementary girls with one exception. For their formal uniform, middle school girls may choose to wear a skirt instead of the jumper. The skirts will be of the same plaid as the jumpers. With the skirts, the girls will wear white oxford shirts, white or navy tights or socks, and black dress shoes.

Middle School Boys will follow the same dress code as the elementary boys.

### HCCA UNIFORM DO'S:

- Do tuck shirts in at all times.
- Do wear black belts with any shorts or pants that have belt loops.
- Do keep uniform in good condition.
- Do wear your dress uniform on Formal Days and on Field Trip days.
- Hair accessories should match or blend well with the uniform.
- Hair must be a natural color. No hair feathers or hair attachments allowed.
- Young men must be well groomed, including facial hair. Hair must be off shirt collars.

### HCCA UNIFORM DON'TS:

- Don't wear sweatshirts or jackets (other than a blue cardigan or jacket with school logo) all day with your school uniform.
- Don't wear uniforms that do not fit well.
- Don't wear shirts with faded monograms.
- Don't wear clothes that have unraveled hems or rips.
- Don't wear shirts that have noticeable stains.
- Don't wear tattoos or body glitter to school.
- No body piercings other than on the ear for girls. No earrings allowed on boys.
- Hair must be a natural color. No hair feathers allowed.
- Don't wear boots, sandals or flip-flops.

### FRIDAY DRESS:

On Fridays students are allowed to wear blue jeans or blue jean shorts and a Holy Cross T-shirt or polo.

- The denim must be blue—no other colored denim.
- Shorts must be of an appropriate length—no shorter than 3" above the knee.
- Jeans must be in good condition with no rips or holes.
- T-shirts must be official Holy Cross wear – none that are homemade or produced by someone other than HCCA or its approved agents.
- If a student chooses not to wear jeans and a t-shirt, he/she must wear their regular complete school uniform.
